Tiger sale aims to save them in wild

THIS work of art is on show in London at an exhibition which aims to support wildlife.

This piece is called Janu by Chila Kumari Singh Burman and is valued at £35,000.

It is part of a collection of commissioned, limited edition art rugs and pieces by artists including Ai Weiwei, Peter Doig and Anish

Kapoor for Sotheby's Tomorrow's Tigers exhibition and fundraising sale at Sotheby's in London which is raising awareness and funds for the World Wildlife Fund.

A Sotheby's spokesman said: "With the exception of Ai Weiwei's unique contribution to this selling exhibition, the rugs are each made in a limited edition of up to 10, with

profits supporting tiger conservation globally.

"In this lunar year of the Tiger, the aim of this fundraising initiative is to support efforts to boost wild tiger numbers and to alleviate the threat posed to rapidly depleting wild tiger populations."
